9 June 2024



How to vote?

1

Check whether you are registered to vote at the district electoral commission in your place of permanent residence. You can also obtain a certificate confirming the right to vote to be able to vote in any voting district in Poland.

2

Verify who you can vote for and choose the candidate you think will best represent your interests at the European level.

3

Find your polling station and its opening hours. Voters in Poland vote in district electoral commissions in their place of permanent residence.

4

Come to your designated polling station on election day (9 June 2024, Sunday).

Don't forget to bring a valid ID card or passport.

5

Receive a ballot and **vote** for the candidate you choose.
